- ❖ Two categories: Traditional apple pies (2 crust pie made with apple filling), and non-traditional pie (made mostly from apples but with other ingredients, such as other fruits, nuts, cream, etc.) Contestants may only enter one pie per category.
- ❖ Ribbons will be awarded for first, second and third place in both categories and one overall winner will be selected.
- ❖ Contestants must be from 14 years to 114 years old – let's bring the generations together to celebrate our country.
- ❖ Include one copy of your recipe. The winning recipe will be posted on the Storytelling Arts Center of the Southeast (SACS) website.
- ❖ No commercial pies or store-bought pies or fillings – homemade only!
- ❖ Piecrusts can be made or purchased.
- ❖ Pies must be wrapped or covered and in non-returnable pie tins. Pies will not be returned.
- ❖ Please no names or identification on pie or pie tin.
- ❖ Pies must be served at room temperature and cannot require refrigeration.
- ❖ Pies will be judged based on flavor, filling (consistency, doneness, moistness, taste), and overall appearance. Decisions of the judges are final.
